**(PRACTICING) CATHOLIC RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS**

**Shake Off the Dust**

Our kitchen floor is at least 35 years old, and it's the ugliest color to come out of the '80s. But it's a good, durable floor, and my husband, bless his heart, guards it like it was a finely finished hardwood imported from Brazil.

Every time the kids track mud and sand across its vinyl surface, he immediately gets down on his hands and knees and lovingly wipes the mess away. I'm too impatient to do this myself — we have kids, so we're going to have a dirty floor, is my attitude. But this is the hill upon which my husband dies. On hands and knees, scraping dirt off an almost 40-year-old floor, he is the silent, long-suffering sentry, and if it kills him, he will keep these floors pristine. He is Gandalf, and the dirt is the Balrog. You shall not pass.

"Shake the dust off your feet." This is what Christ tells his disciples to do when they — and his word — are rejected. Shake the dust off your feet in testimony against them. Why does he say that? It's not an act of dismissal. It's not a thumbed nose or a stuck-out tongue. No, it's an act of caution: Don't bring it with you. Leave it there.

When we walk through the world, we pick up a lot of dirt. Misguided notions, disordered priorities, habits, and desires that we never noticed until we realized they left a trail. We come into a situation intending to do what is right, but somehow it all goes sideways, and we walk away from it with detritus clinging to us in places we don't notice. They wouldn't listen. They'll see, we think. Oh, they'll see. They'll see how right I was. Pride and vengeance hitch a ride on the soles of our feet, and we track them all through the world.

What to do about this? You can be like me with my ugly old floor. You can shrug your shoulders and say, "It happens, I guess. I'm only human. I meant well."

But here's what would be better: be like my husband. Get down on your knees and get rid of the dirt. Stop the trail in its tracks.

El piso de nuestra cocina tiene al menos 35 años y es el color más feo de los años 80. Pero es un piso bueno y duradero, y mi esposo, bendito sea, lo protege como si fuera una madera fina importada de Brasil.

Cada vez que los niños recorren la superficie de vinilo con barro y arena, él inmediatamente se pone de rodillas y limpia con amor el desorden. Soy demasiado impaciente para hacerlo yo misma: tenemos niños, así que vamos a tener el suelo sucio, esa es mi actitud. Pero ésta es la colina sobre la que muere mi marido. De rodillas, raspando la tierra de un piso de casi 40 años, él es el centinela silencioso y sufrido, y si eso lo mata, mantendrá estos pisos impecables. Él es Gandalf y la tierra es el Balrog. No pasara.

"Sacúdete el polvo de los pies." Esto es lo que Cristo les dice a sus discípulos que hagan cuando ellos (y su palabra) sean rechazados. Sacude el polvo de tus pies en testimonio contra ellos. ¿Por qué dice eso? No es un acto de desprecio. No es una burla ni una lengua fuera. No, es un acto de precaución: no lo traigas contigo. Déjalo ahí.

Cuando caminamos por el mundo, recogemos mucha suciedad. Nociones equivocadas, prioridades desordenadas, hábitos y deseos que nunca notamos hasta que nos dimos cuenta de que dejaban un rastro. Llegamos a una situación con la intención de hacer lo correcto, pero de alguna manera todo sale mal y salimos de ella con detritos adheridos a nosotros en lugares que no notamos. No quisieron escuchar. Ya verán, pensamos. Oh, ya verán. Verán que tenía razón. El orgullo y la venganza viajan en las plantas de nuestros pies y los rastreamos por todo el mundo.

¿Qué hacer al respecto? Puedes ser como yo con mi viejo y feo piso. Puedes encogerme de hombros y decir: "Supongo que sucede. Solo soy humano. Tenía buenas intenciones."

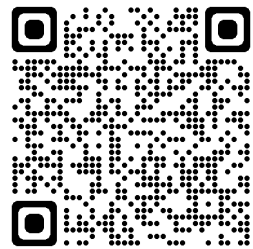
Pero esto es lo que sería mejor: ser como mi marido. Ponte de rodillas y deshazte de la suciedad. Detén el camino en seco.

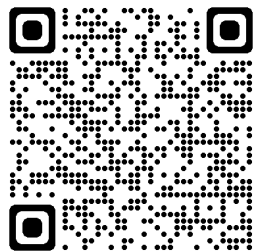

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings from Ridgecrest: Let us resume with the quotes from the priests' retreat: The next quote is, "Some saints are better admired than imitated (Saint Francis de Sales)." Admiring a saint is easier than imitating one. To be admired is to be inspired. It is to be in awe. It is to be amazed. To imitate a saint is to follow in their footsteps. It is to do what they do. Let us examine some examples. Saint Goretti died when she was only eleven years old. She refused to lose her virginity when she was attacked. She chose death over being raped. She believed that God would not like that. How many of us would give up our lives in order not to offend God? We admired Saint Goretti, but how many of us can imitate her? In early Christianity, there were many heresies. One of them was called Novatianism. If one betrayed the Catholic faith by surrendering to the gods of Rome, one was automatically excommunicated. One would spend the rest of their lives doing penance and asking God for forgiveness. It would be up to God to forgive the repentant sinner (https://en.m.wikipedia.org/wiki/Novatianism). Many were martyred because they refused to give in to the foreign gods. It is admirable to see people dying for their faith, but how many of us are willing to imitate them? A third example is the Little Flower (Saint Therese of Lisieux). She was so young when she entered the Carmelite Order. It was a cloistered order. She spent nine years before she died at the age of 24. She contracted tuberculosis. She suffered greatly. She did little works of charity that were not recognizable by the other nuns. It was not until she died that the world began to know about her little way. How many of us are willing to surrender totally to God and not be recognized by others? How many of us are willing to suffer greatly from an incurable disease. She is greatly admired, but how many are willing to imitate her way? God bless.

Saludos desde Ridgecrest: Resumamos con las citas del retiro de los sacerdotes: La siguiente cita es: "Algunos santos son más admirados que imitados (San Francisco de Sales)". Admimir a un santo es más fácil que imitarlo. Ser admirado es estar inspirado. Es estar asombrado. Es para asombrarse. Imitar a un santo es seguir sus pasos. Es hacer lo que ellos hacen. Examinemos algunos ejemplos. Santa Goretti murió cuando ella tenía solo once años. Se negó a perder su virginidad cuando fue atacada. Eligió la muerte antes que ser violada. Ella creía que a Dios no le gustaría eso. ¿Cuántos de nosotros daríamos nuestras vidas para no ofender a Dios? Admirábamos a Santa Goretti, pero ¿cuántos de nosotros podemos imitarla? En el cristianismo primitivo, había muchas herejías. Uno de ellos se llamaba novatianismo. Si uno traicionaba la fe católica al rendirse a los dioses de Roma, era automáticamente excomulgado. Uno pasaría el resto de su vida haciendo penitencia y pidiendo perdón a Dios. Le correspondería a Dios perdonar al pecador arrepentido (https://en.m.wikipedia.org/wiki/Novatianism). Muchos fueron martirizados porque se negaron a ceder a los dioses extranjeros. Es admirable ver a la gente morir por su fe, pero ¿cuántos de nosotros estamos dispuestos a imitarlos? Un tercer ejemplo es la Pequeña Flor (Santa Teresa de Lisieux). Era muy joven cuando ingresó en la Orden Carmelita. Era una orden de clausura. Pasó nueve años antes de morir a la edad de 24 años. Contrajo tuberculosis. Sufrió mucho. Hizo pequeñas obras de caridad que no eran reconocibles por las otras monjas. No fue hasta su muerte que el mundo comenzó a conocer su pequeño camino. ¿Cuántos de nosotros estamos dispuestos a rendirnos totalmente a Dios y no ser reconocidos por los demás? ¿Cuántos de nosotros estamos dispuestos a sufrir mucho por una enfermedad incurable? Es muy admirada, pero ¿cuántos están dispuestos a imitar su camino? Dios los bendiga.

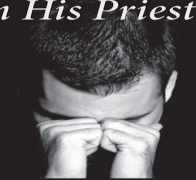
